SS4A (Safe Streets for All) Grant

- We did not receive any applications for the Transportation Alternatives Program that were due in mid-September. With the recommendation by the Board, we will go ahead and give additional funding for the Republic Sidewalk project of \$75k. This will leave \$375k to roll over to the next cycle.
- Received 5 applicants for the Consolidated Grant Program: 1 from Moccasin Express from
 Spokane Tribe, 2 from Colville Confederated Tribes, 1 from Cancer can't, and 1 from the new
 RTPO for RTPO Funding. WSDOT has these applications and will review them between
 September 18th October 31st. They will meet with the jurisdictions who put in their projects and
 make any recommended updates or changes to their application. Final Applications due
 November 19th in GMS. November 21st will be a special TAC meeting for presentation of projects
 and ranking. Rankings will be approved in the December meeting.
- The draft for the Transportation Improvement Project was posted for public comment in September and will end on October 16th. The plan will go before the TAC committee and to the Board in October. November 1st those projects are due to WSDOT.
